The Basic Cardiac Rhythm Interpretation course provides the nurse with fundamental skills needed to analyze and interpret the patient's cardiac rhythm, determine what needs to be assessed, and what actions need to occur.

- Review the anatomy and physiology of the heart, including the conduction system and its relationship with patient's cardiac rhythm cycle.

 - *Junctional Rhythms
 - *AV Blocks
 - *Ventricular Rhythms
 - *Paced Rhythms
- Demonstrates the ability to discriminate between normal, significant, and lethal cardiac rhythms including causes and potential treatments.
