Objectives:

- 2. Discuss pathophysiology of burn injuries and how to use it to our advantage as clinicians in a rural setting.
- 3. Define three major priorities of initial burn care in the rural environment.
- 4. Introduce initial fluid resuscitation strategy that is easily applicable and provides cognitive offloading for the clinician and improved care for the patient.
- 5. Discuss major burn injuries and define "burn shock."
- 6. Provide framework for pain management in the burn patient population.
- 7. Provide a brief insight into the trajectory of burn care after arrival at the burn center.
